



# How to Apply for Housing at WCU



On-campus housing is not secure until all steps are completed. Starting in March 2016, we will begin contacting students who have been accepted with on-campus housing and paid the Admissions acceptance fee on a rolling basis via WCU email. The Village Apartments and East Village Apartments are the only on-campus housing options specifically reserved for incoming transfer students. A limited number of beds may be available in the north campus affiliated residence halls on a first-come, first-serve basis.



# Frequently Asked Questions



## What fees are due now?

Incoming students who are living on-campus will pay \$400 in fees during the application process, which is a combination of the \$200 Admissions acceptance fee and a \$200 non-refundable application fee for housing. Affiliated housing applicants will pay the \$200 non-refundable application fee when completing the online lease application. The application fee is non-refundable and non-transferable.

## What steps do I need to take if I require a special accommodation?

Please call the Office of Residence Life and Housing Services at 610.436.3307 to discuss your individual circumstances and review the housing options that will best meet your needs.

## Why can't I choose my housing as soon as I pay the Admissions fee?

It takes several business days for the information regarding your payment to be communicated from the online payment service to the housing offices. It could take up to two weeks between making a payment and receiving housing instructions.

## How will you contact me?

University Student Housing will utilize your WCU email address as the primary point of contact. All important communication from the University will be sent to your WCU email. ## Can I use financial aid towards housing costs?

Yes! For affiliated housing, the semester rent is due in full on August 1st and January 1st. If you are receiving financial aid to assist with the cost of housing, you will need to make temporary monthly out of pocket payments to USH until financial aid disburses your refund.
